Recruitment Tips

- **This is the time to be yourself. The girls in the houses are just as nervous as you.**
- **Picture for Resume/Application. Use a graduation picture but a casual picture is fine also.**
- **GPA is a cut off for many of the sororities. If you have a lower GPA, there is a chance you will be released....**



Recruitment Tips Con't

- **References/Recommendations – It is the sororities responsibility to acquire “Recs” but it is better to have someone who knows you to write the “Rec” than for them to get someone who doesn’t know you to write it.**
- **Bring walking shoes/flip flops with you to wear while walking in between houses – you will leave your purse outside when going into the houses.**



Recruitment Tips Con't

- **Attire – Don't dress too casual on first day. Do not wear excessive make up or provocative clothing. Follow Greek Life Office's recommendations.**

- **Don't smoke right before you go into the houses and don't chew gum while in the houses.**



Recruitment Tips Con't

- **Watch what you put on your Facebook and Myspace pages – Sororities will be looking at it!**

- **Do not go into recruitment only considering one house – you can be happy in many of the houses.**

- **All women will visit each sorority during the Open House; remaining rounds are by invitation only**

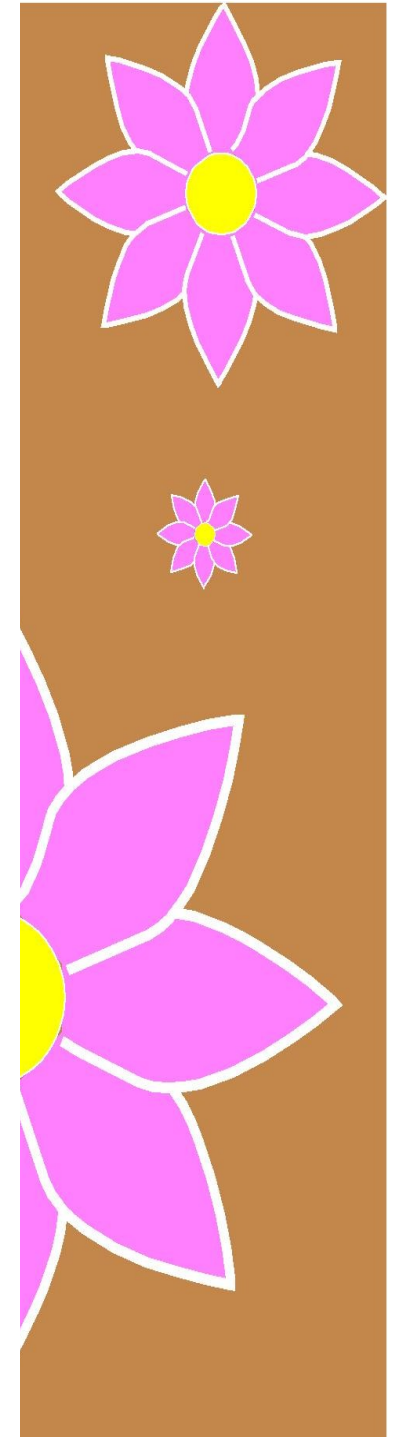

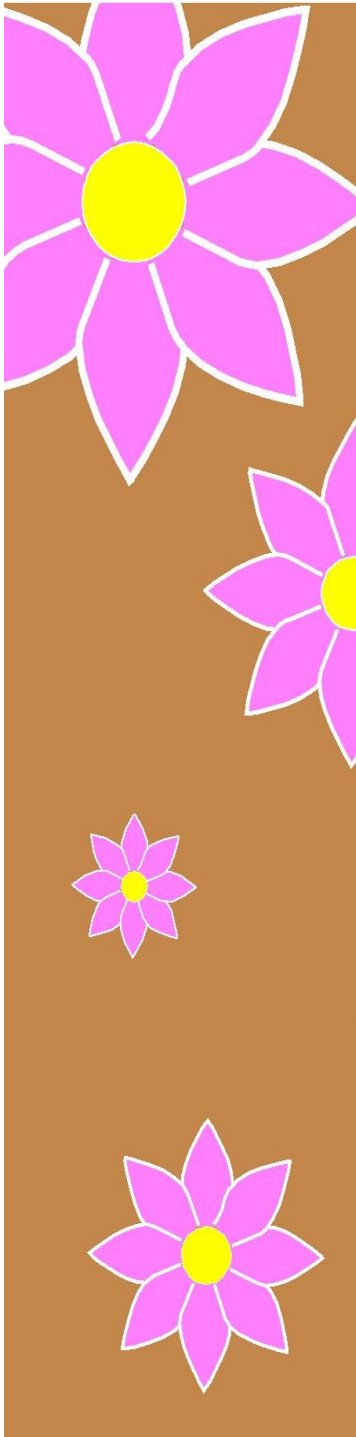

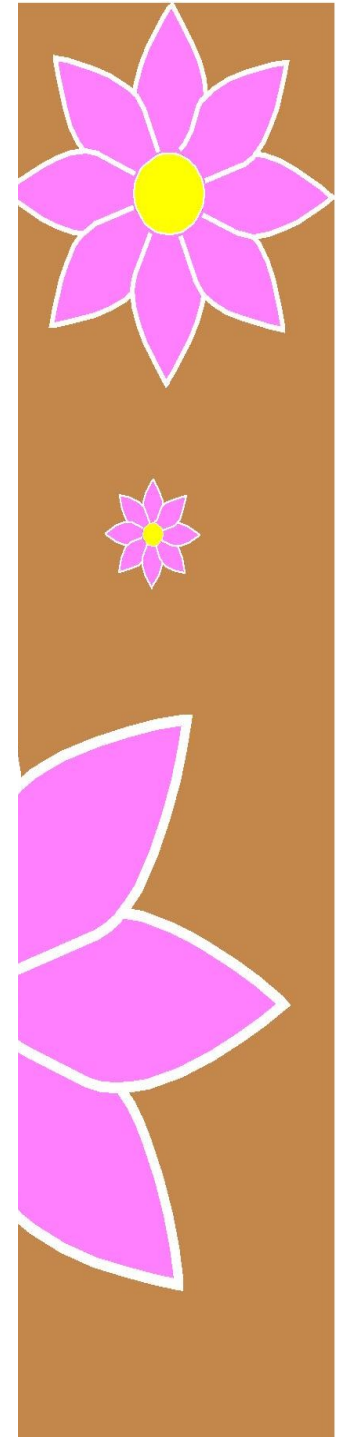
